Constitution, Rules & Regulations: (Chair – Steve Grapp, Co-Chair - Brian Welch)

Brian Welch reported that Phase 2 of the Karok and W Choctaw swale was completed last week. He indicated that they started the work on Access 2 at the bottom of Potawamie. He also reported that we are not sure if the Eastside culverts project will get done this year due to a delay in acquiring piping for the culverts.

Suprena Lohrer reported that she received the quote for the walking path. The community voiced a need for a safe place to walk. We will present the one-mile-long, proposed walking path information at the Property Owners' Meeting. The community will have a chance to review and vote if we should move forward with the plan.

Building Review: (Scott Kutzley, Marty Ditello)

Choctaw Utilities: (Kathi Platter, Scott Kutzley)

Kathi Platter reported that Choctaw Utilities met for their quarterly meeting on Monday.
